

## **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)**

### **What time is your Religious Education Program?**

From September to Memorial Day, we have two worship services at 9 and 11 am. The nursery is open for both services. Currently, we only offer Children and Youth Religious Education Classes during our 9 am service. We also offer a summer series of Sunday morning workshops for our Children and Youth.

### **On the schedule, what do Children's Chapel, Multigenerational, and All Ages mean?**

On the First Sunday/Children's Chapel, we begin with a children's chapel for grades Pre-K through 6th instead of attending the first 20 minutes of the service. (All other ages begin in their classrooms.) We have a special curriculum those days, which reinforces what we discussed during our Children's Chapel.

This happens to be the same theme that you are experiencing in the Sunday Morning Service.

Multigenerational Services are special services where everyone attends the morning services together. There are no classes these days, and the worship is intentionally designed for all ages. Finally, All Ages Religious Education Days occur during Holiday Weekends where we imagine many families are out of town. All Ages, from Preschool to Sr. High are together for a special class.

### **Do you charge any program fees?**

The Children's Religious Education Program is supported through the annual operating budget. We do ask for a nominal program fee for our Our Whole Lives (OWL) Courses, as these courses require facilitators to attend an off-site training program. There are occasional costs associated with the High school Youth Group for offsite events. However, no family is turned away from an activity due to the inability to pay. For scholarships and fee waivers, talk with our Director of Religious Education.
